- 2015-2016 General Education Committee Report

 - No responses from Creative Arts

 - ETS data was received from Dr. Carol Reifschneider and included in this report.
 - Recommendations are the same from last year's report.

 - NRSG 305 HealthCare Ethics
 - NRSG320 Nursing Informatics/ HealthCare informatics
 - No proposal to create list these as General Education
 - Needs to go through the college meeting then back through General Education, Curriculum, and Academic Senate
 - Arlys stated that the College of Education Arts & Science and Nursing approved the creation of the Gen Ed courses in April.
 - Jennifer stated she would check the college minutes notes.
