 - Doesn't really fit Cat. VI
 - Terri has concerns it doesn't fit this category
 - Since approve by Board of Nursing and the Board of Regents; do we have to do it?
 - Would have to resubmit any changes through the process.
 - Spike questions would it fall under Philosophy.
 - Suggested look at changing the Subcategory Humanities in Cat VI to incorporate Ethics not under Philosophy.
 - Approve with stipulation to subcategory to address Cat VI Sub Cat. Humanities to included Ethics not under Philosophy.
