Bob Johnke was present to answer questions regarding math placement and competencies in relation to the new general education package. Bob distributed a handout on mathematics proficiency admission standards to four-year campuses of the Montana University System.

Answers were given related to SAT/ACT scores and class placement; completion of MATH 095 and placement based on the Compass Test; and the impact of the BOR policy about math competencies from high school and success in college math. Also given, was guidance on measurable outcomes.
