CORRESPONDENCE:

LEGISLATIVE AUDIT – The general education policy is in the last stages of completion while the minimum grade topic continues. The AAS and BAS are being worked on and will be coming forward.

GRADUATE PROGRAMS INVITATION – Darlene Sellers extended an invitation to the senate members to attend the oral defenses in Great Falls Friday and Saturday. Observing the defenses may better explain the workload of faculty who teach graduate courses.

ASSESSMENT INSTRUMENT – At the last Board of Regents' meeting, the issue of administration evaluation by faculty was discussed. A draft based on responsibilities and duties for the Chancellor and Provost & Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs was distributed.
