Mary Pappas is submitting the attached policy change. It is a statement concerning admission to the Nursing program and meets the needs of students who do not meet the 2.75 GPA requirements. According to Mary, it should be included in the admission requirements for Nursing students section of the catalog.

Students who do not meet the 2.75 cumulative grade point average requirement for admission to the nursing program at MSU-Northern may take a standardized examination designed to predict success in nursing. The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) is used to screen students for admission when the GPA does not meet the requirement of 2.75.
