THE VALUE OF YOUR GENERAL EDUCATION DEGREE



Not every student starts college with a clear idea of which degree program to pursue. Some students may have a degree path where completing a two year degree helps them be better prepared to meet their career goals, such as dental hygienist, and will work with an advisor to meet those entry requirements within this program.

The Associate of Arts program at Montana State University-Northern is designed for these students to complete the general education requirements while deciding which major is a best match or taking directed elective course work for a planned transfer to another institution.

Completion of the Associate of Arts degree at Northern satisfies all Bachelor degree general education requirements throughout the Montana University system.

Complete coursework common to all degree programs and earn an Associate of Arts Degree - General Education. Continue on in a four year program at Montana State University- Northern. Complete your general education classes in Havre, and transfer to another Montana University System institution to finish your Bachelor's degree.
